This funding will be used to

- Ensure that students in Prep-year 3 who are at risk of falling below a “C” in English are case-managed and provided with additional support.
- Fund a fortnightly playgroup at the school to enhance community engagement and facilitate transitions to prep.
- In-service teaching staff to enhance their ability to support literacy learning.

Our initiatives include

- Intensive literacy support for students in Prep-year 3 at risk of falling below a “C” in English.
- Fortnightly community playgroup
- Ongoing emphasis on the professional development of teachers as literacy leaders in the school.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ a casual teacher aide to provide intensive literacy support, four days per week to students in Prep-year 3 at risk of falling below a “C” in English (\$11, 650).
- Employ a casual teacher aide to be the fortnightly playgroup organiser (\$2,760).
- Fund the professional development of staff to enhance their ability to support literacy learning (\$1,752).
