This funding will be used to


- Improve the percentage of students attaining "C" or above in English to > 80%.

Our initiatives include


- Case managing and supporting students at risk of falling below a "C" in English by providing intensive literacy support including the delivery of Speech Language Therapy programs. We will be working towards a target of 85% of students attaining an A-C in English.
- Funding professional development opportunities in reading to inform our inquiry cycle.

Employing a casual teacher aide to provide intensive literacy support, four days per week to students at risk of falling below a "C" in English and those on Speech Language Therapy programs.	\$14,724
