## Our initiatives include


- Providing intensive literacy support for students at risk of falling below a 'C' in English.  
Evidence base: State School Improvement Strategy 2021-2025 Priority Success and wellbeing for all children and students as they transition through each stage of learning in an inclusive education system.
- Enabling teacher planning days each term for teachers to gain a deep understanding of the "know" and "do" of each unit and to allow assessment practices to be front-ended for improved student success.  
Evidence base: State Schools Improvement Strategy 2021-2025 Priority: Continuous improvement in the access to, and teaching, learning and assessment of the Australian Curriculum.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing a teacher aide for 8 hours per week to ensure that all students have access to the Australian Curriculum at their level and are engaged and improving - \$13,000
- Fund teacher planning days each term - \$4,107
